Please check the spelling of your name on the Run Roster when you check in at Wrightwood. We will engrave your name on the Finisher Plaque, as it appears on the Roster. We will not be responsible for mis-spelled names, if it is the same as on the Roster. There will be an additional fee, if we must engrave a second plaque.

This will be the only correspondence to the runners. Check the AC100 website periodically for any updates on conditions in ANF. The final word on trail condition and support crew information will be at the Wrightwood Trail Briefing on Friday. If you have problems or concerns prior to race weekend, the best way to communicate with Run Management is via email.
